EUROFLEETS 2ND CALL

The EU project EUROFLEETS "Towards an alliance of European research fleets" was launched in September 2009 aiming at developing the coordination within European research fleets. This project fosters the shared use of European research vessels and associated equipment.

A central aim of EUROFLEETS is to provide access to research vessels for all European scientists and their partners on the basis of scientific excellence covering all fields of marine science from environmental and biodiversity protection, to coastal zone management, geodynamics and climate change research.

After the successful implementation of a combined call for ship-time on global and regional class research vessels in 2010, EUROFLEETS will launch its **2nd call** for ship-time on regional vessels in **February 2011**.

Priority will be given to proposals requesting ship-time on-board those research vessels which were not deployed in conjunction with the "Regional 1" call in 2010. Applications from user groups with limited access to marine infrastructure, or applications including such new user groups are encouraged and will be given credit for during the evaluation process

The call opening for full proposal submission is expected to be on the **17th of February 2011**. Indicative date for call closure is **Monday 30th of April 2011**. Taking into account the evaluation and approval processes, the successful projects are expected to start their cruises in **Spring 2012**, at the earliest.
